Re: Millionaire Party House Games Seed Money

Dear Qualified Organization:

Section 432.110a(d) of the Act states, "A qualified organization shall not receive more than \$15,000.00 in exchange for imitation money or chips in 1 day of a millionaire party." To ensure compliance with this law, effective immediately, the \$15,000.00 maximum exchange limitation must be reduced by the value of the startup bank of chips ("seed") required for house games. Upon seeding a house game, the total value of the seeded chips must be deducted from the \$15,000.00 maximum exchange limit.

Only one qualified organization may seed and have its chips in play at any one table.

Your organization must utilize the current version of the Millionaire Party financial statement and game records included with this license packet. You may locate the current version of these documents at www.michigan.gov/mgcb → Millionaire Party → Forms → Game Records.
