ORDER IMPLEMENTING EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-20 EXTENDING SHUTDOWN THROUGH APRIL 13, 2020
John Carlo, Peter Battista, Margaret Zayti Partnership, d/b/a Northville Downs, currently operate under a license issued in accordance with the Horse Racing Law of 1995, MCL 431.301 – MCL 431.336, as amended (the Act), and the administrative rules promulgated thereto.
On March 10, 2020, Governor Whitmer issued Executive Order 2020-4. The order declared a state of emergency across the State of Michigan under section 1 of article 5 of the Michigan Constitution of 1963, the Emergency Management Act, 1976 PA 390, as amended, MCL 30.401-30.421, and the Emergency Powers of the Governor Act of 1945, 1945 PA 302, as amended, MCL 10.31-10.33.
On March 16, 2020, the Governor issued Executive Order 2020-09. Pursuant to this Executive Order, places of public accommodations were ordered closed to ingress, egress, use, and occupancy by members of the public. The order included racetracks. On March 22, 2020, the Governor issued Executive Order 2020-20 which extended the closure until April 13, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. and rescinded Executive Order 2020-09.
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the suspension of the race meeting license and simulcast permit is extended until April 13, 2020 at 11:59 p.m., or as otherwise ordered.
