RESCISSION OF THE ORDER SETTING MINIMUM GUIDELINES FOR CONTINUED OPERATION OF COMMERCIAL CASINOS

With the issuance of the June 17, 2021, Michigan Department of Health and Human Services Rescission of Emergency Orders including the Gatherings and Face Mask Order signed May 24, 2021, the MGCB Order issued May 27, 2021, is rescinded effective June 22, 2021, at 12:01 a.m.

While the MGCB Order will be rescinded, it should be noted that while the number of novel coronavirus (COVID-19) cases are diminishing, the desired vaccination rate has not yet been reached. Given the respiratory nature of the virus, the casinos are strongly encouraged to continue the smoking ban initiated by that order.
