I am pleased to share with you what Student Scholarships and Grants (SSG), within the Michigan Department of Treasury - Student Financial Services Bureau, has accomplished during the 2018 fiscal year. The following report provides information about funds administered, and the number of Michigan students awarded at each institution.

Our goal during the year was to enhance the customer service experience and to expand resources to help Michigan students afford college. We focused efforts on working with high school counselors to encourage students to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and Tuition Incentive Program (TIP) application.

Our data management system, MiSSG allows for easier access for students, counselors and financial aid administrators. Students can quickly set up a portal account where they can view their award information in real-time. Counselors can easily identify which of their students haven't filed a FAFSA or completed their TIP application. It's no longer necessary for students to provide eligibility documentation to their college. Colleges can view student awards and certify enrollment directly from MiSSG.

MiSSG update:

- Added three programs (Dual Enrollment, Fostering Futures, and GEAR UP) for a total of 8 programs.
- Provided assistance to 40,427 MiSSG student users.
- Processed 477,249 unique Free Applications for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

SSG looks forward to continuing our focus on the customer service experience and working with students and parents regarding eligibility for state awards.

The higher number of awarded MCS students exceeded the 2018 appropriation. A total of \$5,402,588 of MCS funds went to MCS students attending private institutions. The lower enrollment of strictly MTG students (16,532) left approximately \$10,695,000 in the MTG fund. Approximately \$6,000,000** was then transferred from MTG to cover the MCS shortfall. Approximately \$4,694,000 remained in the MTG fund to be carried forward for 2019 awards. This illustrates that the funding between the programs should be rebalanced.

**The \$6,000,000 supplemental was based on spring 2017 projections.

Children of Veterans Tuition Grant (CVTG)

The program provides undergraduate tuition assistance to certain children of qualified Michigan veterans who are permanently and totally disabled, MIA, or deceased. The renewable award pays a maximum of \$2,800 per academic year.


