

Children of Veterans Tuition Grant

Fact Sheet for Academic Year 2018-19



Description

The Children of Veterans Tuition Grant (CVTG) provides undergraduate tuition assistance to the children of qualified Michigan veterans who are deceased, totally and permanently disabled, or missing in action (MIA), due to a service-connected injury or illness.

Application

Students must complete an application. The application can be downloaded from www.michigan.gov/mistudentaid or the student can request an application by calling 1-888-447-2687. To check the status of an application, the student can log into the MiSSG Student Portal at www.michigan.gov/missg.

Eligibility

To be eligible for award, a student must:

- Have completed the CVTG application.
- File a current-year Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Be between ages 16 and 26.
- Be the natural or adopted child of a qualifying Michigan veteran.
 - ◆ Stepchildren or grandchildren of the veteran are not eligible.
- Not have been convicted of a felony involving an assault, physical injury, or death.
- Be enrolled in at least six credit hours at a participating institution.
 - ◆ All participating institutions are listed on the last page of this Fact Sheet.
- Possess a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent.
- Be a Michigan resident.
 - ◆ If a dependent student, parent must also be a Michigan resident.
- Be a U.S. citizen, permanent resident, or approved refugee.
- Not be incarcerated.
- Be an undergraduate student.
- Not be in default on any Federal or State student loan.
- For renewal, meet institution's Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) policy.
- For renewal, maintain a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.25.

Qualifying Michigan Veteran Requirements

- Must have been killed in action or died from another cause while serving in a war or war condition in which the United States of America was or is participating; or,
- Must have died or become totally and permanently disabled as a result of a service-connected illness or injury as determined by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs; or,
- Must have been totally and permanently disabled as a result of a service-connected illness or injury prior to death and has now died; or,
- Must be listed as MIA in a foreign country as determined by the U.S. government.

Program Limits

Awards are for an academic year with the amount determined by the student's enrollment status.

- Full-time students can receive up to a maximum of \$2,800.
- Three-quarter time students can receive up to a maximum of \$2,100.
- Half-time students can receive up to a maximum of \$1,400.

Students may receive scholarship assistance for up to four academic years and a total of up to \$11,200. Current and future awards are subject to available and approved funding.
