

2018 Michigan Energy Assistance Program Grants

On November 8, 2017 the Michigan Agency for Energy (MAE) invited applications for additional funds from the 2018 MEAP Grantees.

Applications for additional funding were submitted by eight of ten grantees by the November 15, 2017 deadline. Two grantees that did not submit applications for additional funding are United Way of Jackson County and United Way for Southeastern Michigan.

All eight proposals were funded.

MAE and DHHS approved additional funds for MEAP Grants totaling \$42,820,000 divided among eight grantees.

The approved MEAP Grants now total \$88,320,000 divided among ten grantees:

- Barry County United Way: \$217,480, Barry County.
- Flat River Outreach Ministries, Inc.: \$67,765, Lowell School District.
- Michigan Community Action Agency Association: \$11 million, statewide.
- Society of St. Vincent de Paul of the Archdiocese of Detroit: \$6 million; 39 counties throughout Michigan.
- Superior Watershed Partnership: \$3.1 million, 15 Upper Peninsula counties.
- The Heat and Warmth fund: \$14.1 million, statewide.
- The Salvation Army: \$19.5 million, statewide.
- TrueNorth Community Services: \$23.5 million, statewide.
- United Way of Jackson County: \$4 million, Consumers Energy customers.
- United Way of Southeastern Michigan: \$6.75 million, DTE Energy Co. customers in Macomb, Oakland, and Wayne counties.
