

Low Income / Income Qualified Report Out

- UPPCO - Low Income Programs
 - Superior Watershed Partnerships completed 50 U.S. DOE certified Home Energy Score assessments prior to Governor Whitmer's Stay Home, Stay Safe executive orders through their Energy Conservation Corp (ECC).
 - Refrigerator Replacement Program currently on hold as ECC crews provide COVID-19 response assistance, but eligible customer lists are being compiled.
- Efficiency United Income Qualified Programs
 - Emergency heat pump water heater, ECM furnace fans and ECM circulator pump installs continue in partnership with SEMCO Gas Company.
 - Increased interest and participation from housing commissions to upgrade common area lighting.
 - Continued installation of cold-climate ductless heat pumps in electrically heated housing commissions.
 - Examining and offering no-contact opportunities (virtual assessments, DIY kits)
