Anticipated Reach: 120 Households

Barry County United Way's (BCUW) program combines energy assistance and self-sufficiency services with our team of case managers and the Family Economic Support Office (FESO). Wrap-around services are provided by performing an in-depth needs assessment, referrals, vendor advocacy and energy education as well as short and long-term budgeting to ensure all household needs are met. The premise of the program is to educate, motivate and empower low-income households to become financially successful while moving them towards becoming self-sufficient and providing the basic needs for their families.

Program Details

- Access, Referral and Navigation Partner with MDHHS.
- Enrollment onto Affordable Payment Plans.
- Case management, financial mentorship and coordination with employment services.
- Energy payment assistance for all types of household heating fuels up to the \$2,000 cap.
- Households responsible for 10% or more of bill depending on program enrollment and payment history.
