

Synopsis of Michigan Renewable Energy Legislation 2015-2016 Pending or Passed Legislation¹

Zoning

- HB 4065 – <http://legislature.mi.gov/doc.aspx?2015-HB-4065> A bill prohibiting within certain distances of a gas line the siting of large capacity wind turbines. Sponsor: Franz.

Off-Shore Wind

- HB 4066 – <http://legislature.mi.gov/doc.aspx?2015-HB-4066> A bill prohibiting DNR deeds, leases or permits for wind turbines in the Great Lakes. Sponsor: Franz.

Renewable Energy Standard
