Behavioral Program: Home Energy Reports(HER) - Option I

Eligibility to use MEMD

- Open to all EO providers
- DTE and CE :
 - Program results are measured using randomized control trials (RCT's) using statistically valid sample size
 - Program has demonstrated energy savings at 90% level of statistical significance
 - Annualized results for both utilities will be combined and used to update the MEMD for the succeeding year
 - M&V performed by an independent evaluator

Program Requirements

- Program delivers paper home energy reports and optionally supplemented with digital communications
- Program offers personalized neighbor comparison based on at least size of home, location, and energy type
- Program provides personalized tips to customers on ways to save energy

Behavioral Program: Home Energy Reports(HER) Option II

Custom Calculation Eligibility

- Each provider must implement a Michigan based HERs pilot
 - Pilot energy savings are imputed using ratio of expenditures applied to statutory target
- Pilot must demonstrate at least 1 year of proven results to be included in the core portfolio of programs.
- Core program M&V protocol:
 - Program results are measured using randomized control trials (RCT's) using statistically valid sample size
 - Program has demonstrated energy savings at 90% level of statistical significance
 - Annualized results used to update each provider's custom calculation for the following year's energy savings (EO credits)
 - 1st year core program uses pilot RCT results
 - M&V performed by an independent evaluator
