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UNDERGROUND NATURAL GAS STORAGE TARIFF

Availability:

Underground natural gas storage service will be made available from the Kalkaska 13/35 Gas Storage Project by CMS Gas Transmission Company (“Kalkaska 13/35 Gas Storage”) to the extent that:

Kalkaska 13/35 Gas Storage has determined that sufficient, uncommitted storage capacity is available to provide the service requested by the customer.

Kalkaska 13/35 Gas Storage and the customer have executed a contract for storage service under this rate schedule.

A customer requesting service on this Tariff shall make written application for such service on a form provided by Kalkaska 13/35 Gas Storage. A storage contract shall also be required.

Characteristic of Service:

Any conditions of service not covered by this tariff shall be provided for in a storage contract between Kalkaska 13/35 Gas Storage and the customer.

Storage Rate:

As negotiated between Kalkaska 13/35 Gas Storage and the customer, the effective rate is made up of the following components:

Reservation:	
Deliverability rate per month:	Negotiated
Capacity rate:	Negotiated
Commodity	
Injection:	Negotiated
Withdrawal:	Negotiated
Fuel Usage:	1.5% initially, then negotiated

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Deliveries of gas by the customer to Kalkaska 13/35 Gas Storage for storage and redeliveries of gas by Kalkaska 13/35 Gas Storage to the customer from storage shall be at mutually agreed upon points of interconnection along the Kalkaska 13/35 Gas Pipeline System.

Due Date and Late Payment Charge:

The due date of the customer's bill shall be not more than 21 days from the date of mailing. A late payment charge of 2% of the unpaid balance outstanding, net of taxes, shall be assessed to any bill that is not paid in full on or before the due date shown thereon.

Term and Form of Contract:

All service under this rate shall require a written storage contract that must be approved by an officer of CMS Gas Transmission Company or a duly authorized agent before it shall be binding upon the Company.

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CONTRACT TRANSPORTATION TARIFF

Availability:

Transportation service will be made available to all customers desiring service to the extent that:

Kalkaska 13/35 Gas Storage has determined that sufficient, uncommitted transportation capacity is available to provide the service requested by the customer.

Kalkaska 13/35 Gas Storage and the customer have executed a contract for transportation service under this rate schedule.

Service:

Any conditions of service not covered by this tariff shall be provided for in a contract between Kalkaska 13/35 Gas Storage and the customer.

Transportation Rate:

FIRM:

Firm transportation is service that is firm. The firm transportation rate and fuel usage is negotiated and included in the negotiated firm storage rate.

INTERRUPTIBLE:

The interruptible transportation rate and fuel usage is negotiated and included in the negotiated interruptible storage rate.

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
