Michigan Public Service Commissioners Coming to Seven Michigan Cities This Fall



The Michigan Public Service Commission (MPSC) invites you to attend one of seven consumer forums being held in Michigan communities this fall.

At the forums, consumers will get the latest information on electric and natural gas rates for the winter and the current status of local and long distance telephone service. Attendees may ask questions and express their concerns regarding service quality or other utility issues.

One of the Commission's three members – Chairman Orjiakor Isiogu, Commissioner Monica Martinez, or Commissioner Steven Transeth – will be at each session to discuss the issues, explain how the Commission makes decisions, and listen to your questions and comments regarding utility service.

“As winter approaches, we want to help Michigan utility customers prepare for the higher heating bills that come with Michigan's cold weather. Customers need to be aware of conservation actions they can take and assistance programs that are available to them,” said Commission Chairman Isiogu. “We welcome the opportunity to meet customers face to face to share information and listen to their comments and concerns on any utility matters of interest to them.”
