ORDER

On February 4, 2004, Tucker & Hughes, P.C., filed a complaint against MCI WORLDCOM Communications, Inc., alleging numerous violations of law. On March 9, 2004, the complainant filed a request to dismiss the complaint with prejudice.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 et seq.
- b. The complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of Tucker & Hughes, P.C., against MCI WORLDCOM Communications, Inc., is dismissed with prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.
