ORDER

On September 16, 2004, Denise Ventimiglia filed a complaint against MCI WorldCom
Communications, Inc., alleging an unauthorized switch of telephone service. On October 21,
2004, the complainant filed a request to withdraw the complaint with prejudice.

The Commission FINDS that:

- a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.; 1969 PA 306,
as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as
amended, 1999 AC, R 460.17101 et seq.
- b. The complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of Denise Ventimiglia against MCI
WorldCom Communications, Inc., is dismissed with prejudice.
