**ORDER**

On July 15, 2009, David Ney filed a complaint against The Detroit Edison Company regarding a dispute over damages to his home following a power outage. On December 15, 2009, the complainant filed a request to withdraw the complaint with prejudice. The Commission finds that the complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of David Ney against The Detroit Edison Company is dismissed with prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.
