**ORDER**

On May 13, 2013, Alger Delta Cooperative Electric Association (Alger Delta) filed an application requesting biennial Commission review and approval of its renewable energy plan as required by Section 23 of 2008 PA 295 (Act 295), MCL 460.1023. In its application, Alger Delta states that its renewable energy plan has not been amended; however it has been updated to reflect actual retail sales in 2011 and 2012, and includes an updated projection of retail sales in 2013-2015.

Section 23(4) of Act 295 requires the Commission to provide an opportunity for public comment on Alger Delta's renewable energy plan. A notice of opportunity for public comment was distributed by Alger Delta. Comments were due by June 12, 2013. No comments were received.

The Commission Staff reviewed Alger Delta's application and recommends that the Commission find that the company continues to be in compliance with the requirements of Act 295.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- A. Alger Delta Cooperative Electric Association's renewable energy plan is approved.
- B. Alger Delta Cooperative Electric Association shall file in this docket a report describing its compliance with the requirements of 2008 PA 295 by July 31 every year until further order of the Commission.
- C. Absent an earlier application filed by Alger Delta Cooperative Electric Association for authority to amend its plan, the renewable energy plan approved by this order shall be reviewed by the Commission during the next biennial review period described in MCL 460.1023(4).

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, under MCL 462.26.
