ORDER

On April 17, 2013, FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. (FirstEnergy) filed an application for approval of its biennial renewable energy plan review.

Section 23(3) of Act 295, MCL 460.1023(3), requires that the Commission provide an opportunity for public comment on FirstEnergy's biennial renewable energy plan. FirstEnergy distributed a notice of the opportunity for public comment in accordance with the instructions of the Commission's Executive Secretary. Comments were due by May 16, 2013. No comments were received.

The Commission Staff reviewed FirstEnergy's application and finds that the previously approved plan is substantially unchanged and further recommends that the Commission find that the company continues to be in compliance with the requirements of Public Act 295 of 2008.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. The renewable energy plan of FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. is approved.

B. FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. shall file a report in this docket describing its compliance with the requirements of Public Act 295 of 2008 by June 30 annually until further order of the Commission.

C. Absent an earlier application filed by FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. for authority to amend its plan, the renewable energy plan approved by this order shall be reviewed by the Commission in two years.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, under MCL 462.26.
