

Equal Housing Opportunity

The Michigan State Housing Development Authority supports fair housing in accordance with the federal fair housing law and the Fair Housing Act of 1988 as amended.

It is illegal to discriminate against any person because of race, color, religion, disability, sex, familial status, or national origin:

-  In the **sale or rental** of housing or residential lots
-  In the **provision** of real estate brokerage services
-  In **advertising** the sale or rental of housing
-  In the **appraisal** of housing
-  In the **financing** of housing
-  **Blockbusting** is also illegal

Any person who believes they have been discriminated against with regard to housing in Michigan may file a complaint with:
