Certified Local Government Grants



By rehabilitating the Boyne City 1910 Waterworks, the City of Boyne City took a community landmark that had been unused for thirty years and returned it to public service. Using federal Certified Local Government grant funds from the State Historic Preservation Office, Community Development Block Grant money, and local funds, the project team rehabilitated the building and returned it to its original role as part of the community's water system.

After three decades of neglect, the building is now a water booster station for Boyne City's water system and is serving the community once again.

Boyne City citizens rededicated the building in July 2011. At the open house, people were overheard saying "It turned out better than I expected," and "I would have never believed it could have been saved!"
