


## 2008 FBI UCR Property Crime in Michigan

Of the 12 Midwestern States identified by the FBI's 2008 Uniform Crime Report (Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Ohio, Wisconsin, Iowa, Kansas, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota), the State of Michigan reported:

- 15% of the total Population
- 14% of all Property Crimes
- 16% of all Burglaries
- 13% of all Larceny-Thefts
- 21% of all Motor Vehicle Thefts




- Michigan reported a *Property Crime* rate of (2,934.8) which was 3% lower than the Regional States rate of (3,026.7) and 9% lower than the United States total rate of (3,212.5).


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## 2008 Property Crime



- Michigan reported a *Larceny-Theft* rate of (1,831.1) which was 16% lower than the Midwestern States rate of (2,122.8).
- Michigan's *Burglary* rate of (741.5) was 9% higher than the Midwestern States rate of (681.1) and 1% higher than the United States total rate of (730.8).



- Michigan reported a *Motor Vehicle Theft* rate of (362.3) which was 38% higher than the Midwestern States rate of (262.6). The state of Michigan's *Motor Vehicle Theft* rate (362.3) was 15% higher than the United States total rate of (314.7).
- In 2008 12% of all *Motor Vehicle Thefts* were cleared by arrest or exceptional means for all agencies in the United States. The State of Michigan cleared 8% of *Motor Vehicle Thefts* by arrest or exceptional means.
