Basic LEIN Operator Training

The Michigan State Police, Criminal Justice Information Center, is now accepting registrations for the 2023 Basic LEIN Operator Training.

Basic LEIN Operator Training is intended for agencies that have direct access to the LEIN and the National Crime Information Center (NCIC). This course targets new LEIN users, including:

- Dispatchers
- Probation Staff
- Law Enforcement Staff
- Parole Staff
- Corrections
- Prosecutor Staff

Basic LEIN Operator Training provides a basic understanding of LEIN and NCIC queries and responses, including the following:

- Access and dissemination
- Missing persons
- Driver and vehicle records
- Password use
- Personal protection orders
- Criminal history records
- Wanted persons
- Stolen vehicles
- Administrative messages

LEIN and NCIC policy requires all operators to be certified within six months of hire and recertified every two years. The LEIN certification test is administered by the agency's Terminal Agency Coordinator (TAC) and will not be given during this class.
