

# PASSENGERS

A 16- OR 17-YEAR-OLD DRIVER'S  
**RISK OF BEING KILLED IN A CRASH:**

INCREASES BY

**44%**

WITH **ONE PASSENGER** 21 OR YOUNGER.

**DOUBLES**

WITH **TWO PASSENGERS** 21 OR YOUNGER.

**QUADRUPLES**

WITH **THREE OR MORE PASSENGERS** 21 OR YOUNGER.

**DROPS**

**62%**

WITH AN **ADULT 35+** IN THE VEHICLE.

WHEN A TEEN DRIVER HAS ONLY TEEN PASSENGERS IN THE CAR, THE FATALITY RATE FOR ALL PEOPLE INVOLVED IN A CRASH INCREASES 51%.



WITH OTHER TEENS IN THE CAR, MALE TEEN DRIVERS WERE NEARLY

**6X MORE LIKELY**

TO PERFORM AN ILLEGAL MANEUVER, AND

**2X MORE LIKELY**

TO DRIVE AGGRESSIVELY BEFORE CRASHING

THAN WHEN DRIVING ALONE.



**FEMALE TEEN DRIVERS, HOWEVER, RARELY DROVE AGGRESSIVELY, WITH OR WITHOUT TEEN PASSENGERS.**
