**Obstruction Police / Obstructing Justice**

**File Class 48000, Obstructing Police**

- Defined as Offenses which interfere with investigation, enforcement, or administration of justice at the police level or at the correctional level in the criminal justice system.
- If an arrest charge of “Resisting Officer” (4801) is submitted under File Class 48000, and an assault on an officer occurs, then an assault File Class (13001, 13002, or 13003) must be included in the incident report and the proper Law Enforcement Officers Killed or Assaulted (LEOKA) data fields must be completed (see below).

**File Class 50000, Obstructing Justice**

- Defined as the impedance, obstruction, interference, or contempt for the proper administration of justice by the courts, a legislative body, or specifically designated commission, etc.
- This File Class is a “Crime Against Society.” LEOKA information does not pertain to this File Class and should be left blank.

**LEOKA - Officer Assaults or Deaths**

If a police officer is the victim of a murder, aggravated assault, non-aggravated assault, or stalking file class, Victim Type must be “Police” and LEOKA data fields (Type of Activity, Type of Assignment, and Originating Reporting Identifier Other Jurisdiction-if applicable) are required.
