1. Appropriation Related for School Safety

At the June State 911 Committee (SNC) meeting, the SNC approved sending a letter to the legislature regarding the appropriation for school safety. After the meeting, the SNC Chair, Mr. Jeff Troyer, received a request from Mr. Rudy Hobbs of the Michigan Legislative Consultants. It was requested that the letter to the legislature not be sent but rather held until a meeting could occur between the representative of the SNC and the Michigan Legislative Consultants.

The meeting held on June 20, 2019, with Mr. Rudy Hobbs and Mr. Tim Ward of Michigan Legislative Consultants consisted of Mr. Jeff Troyer, Ms. Harriet Rennie-Brown, Ms. Lisa Hall, and Ms. April Heinze. The letter to the legislature was brought out for discussion, but the consultants could not retain a copy. Mr. Troyer requested documented information by the close of business on June 21. The information received was forwarded to the members of the Legislative Action Subcommittee (LAS).

The LAS was tasked with the review of the information to consider whether any revisions to the letter were necessary. The members of LAS completed a line by line review and revision of the proposed letter to the legislature. Members also asked Mr. Troyer to complete the final review of the letter so it could be sent as soon as possible. The members were thanked for their time.
