

## 2005 STATE TOTAL Aggravated Assault Victim Information

Definition: Aggravated Assault is an unlawful attack by one person upon another for the purpose of inflicting severe or aggravated bodily injury.

This type of assault is usually accompanied by the use of a weapon or by means likely to produce death or great bodily harm.

Offenses are the unlawful acts reported to a law enforcement agency. Victims are the injured party of the offense.












**Weapons Used**
