Averting Targeted School Violence:

A Summary of the <u>USSS/NTAC Report</u>



Report on 67 averted attacks, identifying intervention points before escalation of behavior.



- Targeted school violence is preventable when communities identify warning signs and intervene (threat assessment).
- Intervene before legal consequences become necessary.
- Students often plan attack due to conflict with classmates.
- Students can best identify and report concerning behaviors.
- Parents & families are critical to recognizing concerning behavior.
- SROs play important role in violence prevention.
- Removing a student from school does not eliminate risk.
- Interest in violent/hate topics to prompt assessment.
- Many plots associated with specific dates of significance.
- Many plotters had access to weapons.
