In all 50 states and the District of Columbia, it is illegal to drive with a BAC of .08 or higher. Throughout the summer, #DriveSober or Get Pulled Over

A DUI can cost you \$10k in attorney's fees, fines, car towing, and lost time at work. #DriveSober or Get Pulled Over. It's the law.

Remember - If you're impaired by any substance, you shouldn't drive. #DriveSober or Get Pulled Over #impaireddriving
