

Final Report Guidelines

Your team's final report must include a five to seven minute video or PowerPoint <u>and</u> a written summary of your campaign. The video or PowerPoint and final report must:

- Clearly explain the campaign
- Describe each activity, including what was done, when, how, and the results
- Describe how Ford Driving Skills for Life was used
- Explain the community outreach and media involvement
- Include the evaluation of the campaign goal(s)
- Contain the completed <u>Expense Tracking Form</u> with copies of receipts and invoices (attached to written summary)
- Be submitted by **March 29, 2019** to:
