

**BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (BYRNE JAG) AWARDS  
GREATER TRI CITIES  
FISCAL YEAR 2016**

- County of Genesee - Genesee County Prosecuting Attorney has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$200,000 for High Crime Cities Prosecution Projects.  
**Summary:** The Genesee County Prosecutor's Office will work closely with the Michigan State Police to ensure offenders are charged and prosecuted in a swift and efficient fashion. This project will support two assistant prosecutors and one legal assistant/paralegal.
- County of Genesee - Genesee County Prosecuting Attorney has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$200,000 for High Crime Cities Prosecution Projects.  
**Summary:** The Genesee County Prosecutor's Office will continue to work with the Flint Police Department and the Michigan State Police in a Major Cases Bureau. Focus will be on efficient and aggressive investigation of violent crimes, including homicide, attempted homicide, felonious assault, first degree criminal sexual conduct, armed robbery, criminal child death cases, and home invasion.
- County of Saginaw - Saginaw County Prosecuting Attorney has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$200,000 for High Crime Cities Prosecution Projects.  
**Summary:** The Saginaw County Prosecutor's Office will target the most violent criminals (many of whom are repeat offenders) for vertical enhanced prosecution. Senior, experienced prosecutors, will work closely with the Michigan State Police, Saginaw Police Department, and the Saginaw County Sheriff's Department, Major Crimes Unit, to achieve a maximum conviction rate. Convicted violent offenders face maximum, lawful prison sentences.
- Michigan Department of State Police - B.A.Y.A.N.E.T. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$99,000 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.  
**Summary:** The Bay Area Narcotics Enforcement Team (B.A.Y.A.N.E.T.) utilizes an undercover multijurisdictional task force to efficiently investigate controlled substances violations and target major narcotic dealers within a six-county region. Partnerships are cultivated to more effectively pursue the criminal element across jurisdictional boundaries.
- Township of Montrose - F.A.N.G. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$218,000 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.  
**Summary:** The Flint Area Narcotics Group (F.A.N.G.) is a multijurisdictional task force that has been serving Genesee County for more than 30 years. F.A.N.G. identifies and targets all levels of drug traffickers, provides drug interdiction, and assists law enforcement with violent crime investigations that have a nexus to illegal narcotics. F.A.N.G. is comprised of local, state, and federal agencies, and municipalities in Genesee County.
- County of Lapeer - T.N.U. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$32,000 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.  
**Summary:** The Thumb Narcotics Unit (T.N.U.) is a multijurisdictional task force that currently serves Huron, Lapeer, Sanilac, and Tuscola Counties. T.N.U. identifies and targets narcotics traffickers of all levels and assists local law enforcement with non-drug, violent/non-violent criminal investigations. T.N.U is comprised of local, state, and federal agencies.
