LIVE SCAN GLOSSARY OF ACRONYMS

AFIS Automated Fingerprint Identification System

A computerized system, maintained by the Michigan State Police. Michigan's central repository for encoding, searching, and matching fingerprints automatically. This system includes the storage and retrieval of fingerprint images.

CHR Criminal History Records

A database, maintained by the Michigan State Police, containing information collected on individuals from criminal justice agencies providing identifiable descriptions and notations of arrests, detentions, indictments, and dispositions arising from sentencing, incarceration, and release.

CRD <u>Criminal Records Division</u>

The Criminal Records Division is a division within the Michigan Department of State Police, and has the responsibility to maintain and operate the AFIS, SNAP, CHR, LEIN and the Michigan Criminal Justice Information Network (MiCJIN).

CTN <u>Criminal Tracking Number</u>

This is a data field within the Michigan Arrest Segment (MAS) and Michigan Court Segment (MCS). Data in this field identifies the prosecutor assigned criminal tracking number for the reported case. This number provides the link between separately reported arrest and charging information, the final court disposition, and any subsequent changes to that disposition.

FBI Federal Bureau of Investigation

Maintains a national fingerprint file for all criminal fingerprint cards submitted by state central repositories.

LEIN Law Enforcement Information Network

The communication network that supplies information sharing for Michigan criminal justice agencies, the portal that links to and provides access to various state and national databases and the hot files.

OCA Originating Agency Case Number

The originating agency case identifier (OCA) that has been assigned by the arresting agency originating the reported arrest, commonly referred to as the complaint number.

PACC Code Prosecuting Attorneys Coordinating Council Code

This code is from the code table maintained by the Prosecuting Attorneys Coordinating Council, used to identify a specific violation of Michigan's criminal code.

SNAP <u>Statewide Network of Agency Photos</u>

The electronic collection and dissemination of digital criminal images including mug shots, scars, marks, and tattoos. Arresting agencies submit images along with Live Scan fingerprint submissions, and have access into the central image system through a secure web browser for searches, digital lineups, and facial recognition.

TCN Transaction Control Number

This mandatory field is assigned by the Live Scan Agency or CRD whenever a digitized fingerprint record is transmitted to AFIS. This number provides the link between separately reported initial arrest information, and prosecutor/law enforcement supplemental information.
