<b>Agenda Item: 2014 Data Presentation</b>
<b>Discussion:</b> Participants were provided with updated 2014 data. From last meeting, Patrick added 2014 data and graphs. Crashes and KA injuries increased for drivers 65+, and fatalities decreased. This was the same for all drivers. The number of licensed drivers age 65+ increased. There was significant discussion regarding changing plan goals based upon Patrick's belief that they are "unattainable". The current goals were made in 2012 and it appeared at that time that crashes were going down, but they have gone the other way. There are specific reports available for the action team on MTCF.
<b>Action:</b> Linda will speak to Kathy Farnum with regard to whether the plan goals may be changed. Patrick will add "A" injuries separately; percent change in licensed drivers. Linda will send data PowerPoint for group review and to suggest data needs. Patrick will break data into the following age groups: 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90+

**Discussion**

- May 14 at MDOT Aeronautics Building – next meeting of the Older Driver Education and Safe Mobility Planning project. Stu will request the data that was presented today to be linked into this project as well.
- Patrick will update the data and will inform team when completed for possible discussion at the next action team meeting.
- DCH and DHS have merged. Tari now works in Aging and Adult Services. Protective services will also come under their area, home health, and most likely others. Still have same structure and field reps working with AAAs and commission. Role in transportation is coordinating information, as they don't have transportation programs. Phil Lewis, communications representative was charged with working on the Gov's senior Web site.
- Beaumont now has 8 hospitals, merged with Oakwood and Botsford now in Oakland, Wayne, and Macomb. New CEO. Donna has partnered with AAA-1B in "Matter of Balance". Presented AARP senior driver program research at ThinkFirst conference. Research shows that the courses are effective at increasing knowledge. AARP started sending out invitation cards to their members to attend the classes and the number of participants is increasing.
- RTA is having a launch rally May 12 at Campus Martius. MyRide2 still going strong.
- Aging Driver Guide Further Outreach – Tari reached out to the Tribal Health Coordinator Association and will have copies at June 2 Older Michiganian Day at the Capitol. Kim, Linda, and Carol are working on a number of other areas to outreach.

- Linda has placeholder in for law enforcement training. TREDs retired patrolman. Development of the tip card. CarFit trying to figure out how that can be supported. Injury prevention coordinators are very interested in the program.
