Discussion:

Sponsorship update: Ford has committed \$10,000

AAMVA – There will no financial support, but they will publish the information on their week in review.

The last batch of funding requests will go out next week. Total sponsorship committed so far: \$81,000 – Kim Larivere & Diane Drago feel we are doing well and not in “panic mode.”

Target audience – who? Do we want to offer CME credits (level 2) to get physicians to attend? This will be discussed at the next NACEM planning meeting (next week).

Speakers:

Toyota has committed to be one of the speakers on the auto panel. Chrysler has declined.

Lou Waters is confirmed as a speaker.

We need to think about whom we would like as a closing speaker and what would we like the closing message to be.

Secretary Fox may come of the conference – if he does attend, we will need to adjust the agenda to accommodate. A formal letter asking him to address the conference was sent.

Emergency Preparedness:

Stuart Lindsay met with Eileen Phifer (MDOT Safety & Security Administrator) to review materials he had gathered. Ms. Phifer recommends a diverse panel and putting “plants” in the audience to spur discussion and ask questions, preventing lulls.

Four major areas:

1. Who is involved in emergency planning
2. What is expected of transit
3. Coordination of all available vehicles
4. Inclusive city/county/state planning

It was suggested we contact FEMA asking them to display a “best practice.”

Listening Sessions: Some will be done – there is a person from FHWA that would like to interview attendees for a study being done.

The Engineering group is interested in the New York City offer to come speak – possibly a lunch speaker for Tuesday.
