



## LAW ENFORCEMENT INFORMATION NETWORK New Generic Vehicle Make Codes

This correspondence is being distributed to authorized Law Enforcement Information Network (LEIN) user agencies to provide notification of newly established generic vehicle make (VMA) codes to be used in LEIN and the National Crime Information Center (NCIC). In order to reduce the need to create new VMA codes, the NCIC created four generic VMA codes. The four codes are for campers, mobile homes, modular construction buildings/homes, and manufactured homes. The codes are to be used when a VMA code does not currently exist, or if it is not possible to determine the manufacturer. The new codes are as follows:

CMPR	Camper
MBHM	Mobile Home
MDCN	Modular Construction Building or Home
MFHM	Manufactured Home

The VMA field allows up to 24 characters. The first four characters must be alphabetic and a valid NCIC-assigned code. The remaining characters are free text, and must contain the name of the manufacturer when the VMA code is AERO, ATV, CMPR, COEQ, CYCL, FARM, MBHM, MDCN, MFHM, SNOW, SPEC, TRLR, or TRUK.

Agencies utilizing the Talon software through a MultiBridge, or other software will need to request the update from their vendor.
