

**BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (BYRNE JAG) AWARDS
NORTHERN MI
FISCAL YEAR 2013**

- 53rd Circuit Court, Family Division - County of Cheboygan has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$100,000 for Juvenile-Focused Community Policing/Community Prosecution.
Summary: Straits Area Youth Promotion Academy (SAYPA) is a multi-dimensional drug, violence and other anti-social behavioral day treatment program for middle and high school age adjudicated delinquents. Using evidence-based practices, SAYPA simultaneously addresses issues in the home, school, and community to prevent out-of-home placement and future delinquent behavior.
- S.T.I.N.G. - Michigan Department of State Police has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$119,855 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: S.T.I.N.G. will conduct undercover criminal investigations in a six-county area by partnering with all agencies in the area to investigate and prosecute criminals who operate across jurisdictional boundaries.
- S.A.N.E. - County of Emmet has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$144,945 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: Straits Area Narcotics Enforcement (S.A.N.E.) is a multijurisdictional task force, comprised of eleven sworn officers, one prosecutor, and two administrative assistants. S.A.N.E. identifies trends of illegal drug use and sales, identifies traffickers and trafficking organizations, and develops criminal cases on these persons.
- H.U.N.T. - County of Alpena has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$87,980 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: This grant will be used to fund the continuation of the Huron Undercover Narcotics Team (H.U.N.T.), a multijurisdictional task force dedicated to the reduction of narcotics crime and related criminal activities. This team utilizes proactive, collaborative policing strategies, public awareness campaigns, and the application of refined intelligence data to achieve its goals.
- S.S.C.E.N.T. - Michigan Department of State Police has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$120,875 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: State, Sheriffs and Chiefs Enforcement Team (S.S.C.E.N.T.) is a multijurisdictional task force that integrates state, county, and local law enforcement resources with the intent to remove drug dealers and conspiracies from the area. S.S.C.E.N.T works to eliminate drug availability and usage along with the violence associated with drug trafficking.
- T.N.T. - County of Missaukee has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$148,500 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: This is a continuation project funding the Traverse Narcotics Team (T.N.T.), which is a multijurisdictional narcotics task force. The unit operates in the counties of Antrim, Benzie, Grand Traverse, Kalkaska, Leelanau, Missaukee, Osceola, and Wexford. The unit consists of two teams of officers concentrating on undercover operations, surveillance, and interdiction.
