Legislative Update

D/S/Sgt. Chris Gerard, House Bill 4946 was introduced by Rep. Beau LaFave. This house bill of racketeering would be expanded to include retail crime. At this time, no committee hearing for Bill 4946. Senate Bill 56 has not moved, since introduced to the Senate on January 23, 2019.

Old Business

Michigan Regional Organized Crime Association (MiROC) Training Conference is next week, September 18, 2019. Currently, there are 116 registered attendees, but expecting approximately 125 attendees. The overhead fund made from this conference will go towards the creation of the webpage.
