

# SOCIETY CRIMES

The **FBI** and **MICR** consider the file classes below as S - Society crimes. However, in cases where there is a domestic relationship between the individual victim and the offender, they may also be reported as G-Government, I-Individual, or P-Police victims.

Always list the victim as “Society” when reporting the above file classes to MICR.

The exception to listing “Society” as the Victim is when the offense *is being forced upon the victim* as in a **domestic violence crime**.

Michigan is required by law to collect domestic violence data. **In 2002, the victim type of I-Individual and/or P-Police officer was allowed on all Society crimes, when the Victim- to-Offender relationship indicates a domestic violence crime was Committed.**

These additional choices of “I” or “P” were added as enhancements to domestic violence reporting only.

## Society Examples:

35001 – Violation of Controlled Substance Act

List Offender who was in possession of the drugs as Offender

List S-Society as the Victim of the offense not the person with the drugs

48000 – Obstructing Police

List Offender as Offender

List S-Society as the Victim of the offense not the Police
