- Michigan Department of State Police - S.W.E.T. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$80,000 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.  
**Summary:** The Southwest Enforcement Team (S.W.E.T.) addresses narcotics-related issues in an eight-county area in southwest Michigan (Barry, Branch, Berrien, Calhoun, Cass, Kalamazoo, St. Joseph, and Van Buren Counties). The team is comprised of detectives from the South Haven Police Department, Kalamazoo Township Police Department, Marshall Police Department, and the Sheriff's Departments of Barry, Berrien, and Kalamazoo Counties, as well as the Michigan State Police and the Drug Enforcement Administration.
