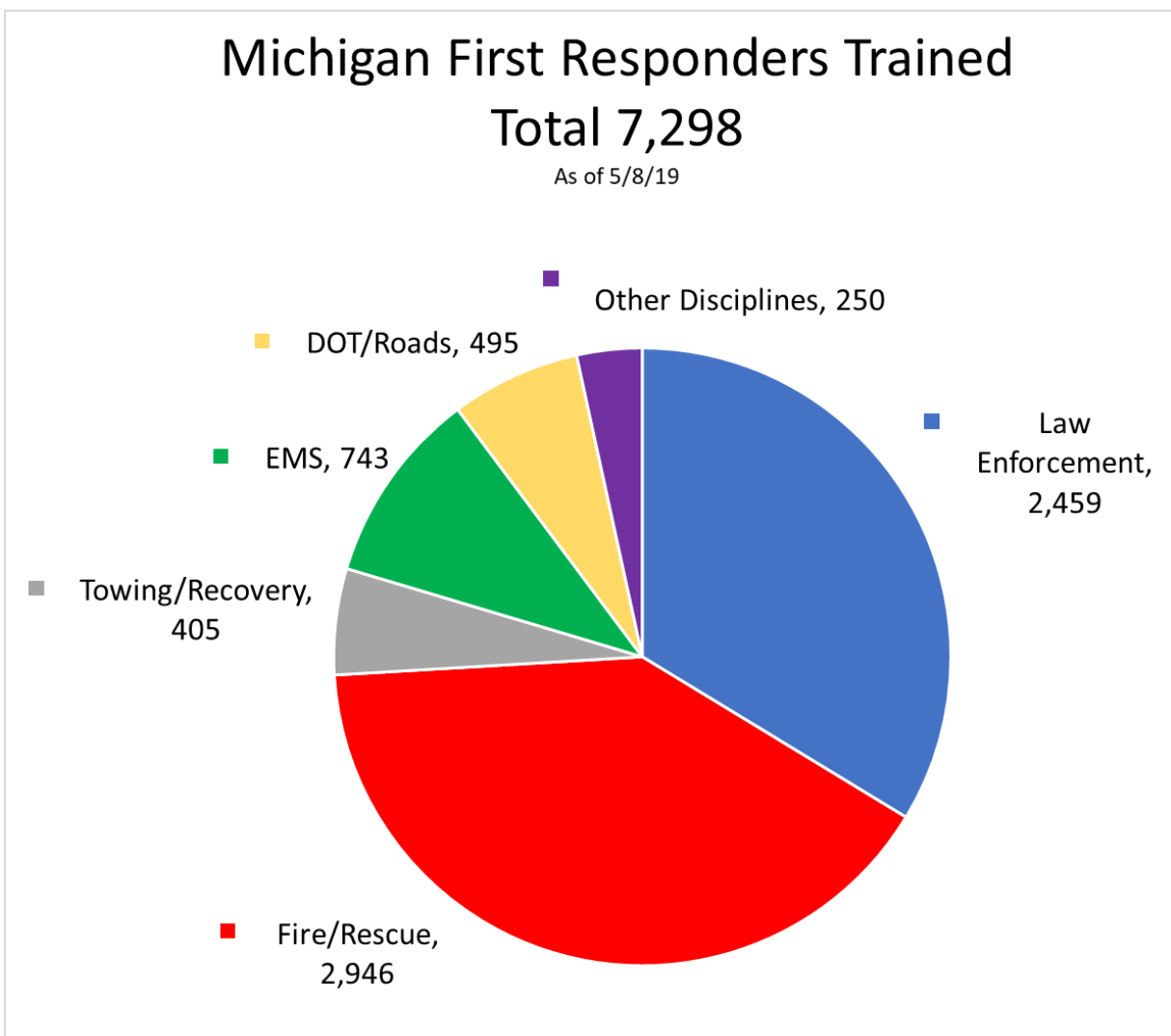


2019 TIM Action Team Accomplishments

- Continued Mi-TIME training in Michigan and achieved goal to train 20% (6,500) of the first responder community by December 31, 2018. Goal was achieved before end of October 2018. Responders trained as of May 8, 2019 is 7,298 with 330 training sessions.
- State 911 Committee has approved the Mi-TIME training for dispatcher continuing education credits.
- Mi-TIME training materials revised to reflect new Move Over Law effective February 13, 2019 which requires motorist to reduce speed at least 10 mph below speed limit when approaching stationary emergency vehicles with emergency lights activated.
- TIM breakout session was well attended at the 2019 Traffic Safety Summit in March 2019. Four speakers presented a “TIM Sampler” and informed the attendees about the topics that included: TIM in Michigan; a Mi-TIME update; coordination of St. Clair County responders and the Blue Water Bridge Operations Center in managing a traffic incident; and a Transportation Operations Center overview.
- TIM in Michigan was presented in October 2018 at the TIM Regional Conference held in Kentucky. Attendees at this conference represented Michigan, Ohio, Kentucky and Indiana.
