

**BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (BYRNE JAG) AWARDS
WEST MI
FISCAL YEAR 2013**

- W.E.M.E.T. - West Michigan Enforcement Team has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$172,680 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: The West Michigan Enforcement Team (W.E.M.E.T.) is a continuing project located in Allegan, Muskegon, and Ottawa Counties that utilizes state, local, and federal officers to address narcotic, gang, and other criminal activity.
- M.E.T. - City of Grand Rapids has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$173,860 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: The Metropolitan Enforcement Team (M.E.T.) is a continuing project which emphasizes the cooperation of local, county, state, and federal agencies with the goal of disrupting and dismantling drug trafficking organizations in Kent County. M.E.T. is unique to other narcotics teams in Kent County and focuses on criminal interdiction techniques to accomplish its goals.
- C.M.E.T. - County of Newaygo has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$136,215 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: Central Michigan Enforcement Team (C.M.E.T.) is a multijurisdictional drug enforcement task force operating in Ionia, Mecosta, Montcalm, and Newaygo Counties. C.M.E.T. cooperates with local, state, and federal partners and is the only drug enforcement team in the four county area.
