

**BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (BYRNE JAG) AWARDS
WEST MICHIGAN
FISCAL YEAR 2016**

- West Michigan Enforcement Team - W.E.M.E.T. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$98,000 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: The West Michigan Enforcement Team (W.E.M.E.T.) is a continuing project in Allegan, Muskegon, and Ottawa Counties, which utilizes state, local, and federal officers to address narcotic, gang, and other criminal activity.
- City of Grand Rapids - M.E.T. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$113,000 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: The Metropolitan Enforcement Team (M.E.T.) is a continuing project emphasizing the cooperation of local, county, state and federal agencies, with the goal of disrupting/dismantling drug trafficking organizations in Kent County. M.E.T. is unique to other narcotic teams in Kent County and focuses on criminal interdiction techniques to accomplish its goals.
- County of Newaygo - C.M.E.T. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$75,000 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: The Central Michigan Enforcement Team (C.M.E.T.) is a multijurisdictional drug enforcement task force which operates in Ionia, Mecosta, Montcalm, and Newaygo Counties. The team cooperates with its state, local, and federal partners and is the only drug enforcement team in the four-county area.
