

**BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (BYRNE JAG) AWARDS  
WEST MI  
FISCAL YEAR 2012**

- W.E.M.E.T. - West Michigan Enforcement Team - has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$209,464 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.  
**Summary:** The West Michigan Enforcement Team (W.E.M.E.T.) is a multijurisdictional task force operating in Allegan, Muskegon and Ottawa Counties. The task force utilizes state, local and federal officers to address narcotic, gang and other criminal activity.
- C.M.E.T. - County of Newaygo - has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$163,881 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.  
**Summary:** The Central Michigan Enforcement Team (C.M.E.T.) is a continuation project for a multijurisdictional drug enforcement task force. The task force will operate in Ionia, Mecosta, Montcalm and Newaygo Counties and will serve as the only drug enforcement team in the four-county area.
- M.E.T. - City of Grand Rapids - has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$210,941 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.  
**Summary:** The Metropolitan Enforcement Team (M.E.T.) is a multijurisdictional task force targeting mid- to upper-level drug traffickers in Kent County. This continuing project emphasizes the cooperation of local, county, state and federal agencies to disrupt and dismantle trafficking organizations.
- Rockford Police Department - City of Rockford - has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$11,700 for Evidence Based Efficiency Projects.  
**Summary:** The Rockford Police Department will update its current records management system to one that provides access to information from Kent County police agencies and other law enforcement agencies throughout Michigan, as well as evidence tracking and daily log functions for officers. The new system will also convert old records for continued access.
