Eligibility

Individuals eligible for the “Retiree of the Year” include retired enforcement or civilian members, including state properties security officers and motor carrier officers, who received a regular, duty disability, non-duty disability, or fully-vested retirement from the department. Unsuccessful nominees from a previous year are eligible for re-nomination if they continue to meet the award criteria. Previous recipients of the award are ineligible.

Nomination Instructions

Nominations will be accepted until **July 15** of the year in which the award will be presented and shall be submitted to the State Services Bureau. Nominations may be submitted by any active or retired member of the department; family, friends, or associates of retired members; and retirees who wish to nominate themselves.

Activities Eligible for Consideration

- Leadership of, or extensive participation in, civic, charitable, humanitarian, or volunteer service organizations.
- Motivation for, and devotion to, enhancing community life.
- Significant efforts to maintain the connections and vitality of the MSP family, even in retirement.
- Voluntary or uncompensated contributions to public safety, law enforcement, or homeland security.
