MEDC	Private Investment	Private capital expenditures committed by businesses as a result of Michigan Economic Development Corporation incentive programs.
MEDC	Jobs	The number of projected jobs created through the Michigan Economic Development Corporation jobs programs.
MEDC	Customer Satisfaction	Overall satisfaction percentage based on surveys of external customers including, businesses, communities, and partner organizations.
MLB	Properties Sold	The number of properties sold for productive use creating a positive economic impact in their community during fiscal year 2019. The number of properties sold increases in Spring and Summer.
MSHDA	Multi-family Housing - People Assisted Annually	The estimated number of people assisted by the Michigan State Housing Development Authority's Multifamily Lending and Low Income Housing Tax Credit programs during fiscal year 2019.
MSHDA	Single Family Housing - People Newly Housed Annually	The estimated number of persons newly housed in single family homes due to a Michigan State Housing Development Authority mortgage during fiscal year 2019.
MSHDA	Homeless People Placed into Permanent Housing Annually	The number of formerly homeless persons who now have permanent housing during fiscal year 2019.
MSHDA	Homeless Veterans Placed into Permanent Housing Annually	The number of formerly homeless veterans who now have permanent housing in fiscal year 2019.
