1) Symptoms screening:

In the past 24 hours, have you experienced any of the following symptoms?

- New/worsening cough       New/worsening shortness of breath       Fever
- Sweats/Chills/Shaking

- If “yes” to **any** of the above symptoms, the employee will be sent home.
  - You will isolate at home for a minimum of 10 days since the onset of symptoms.
  - In order to return to work, you must be symptom and fever free for **24 hours** without the use of fever reducing medications and complete a COVID-19 test (PCR or Antigen test).
  - If a test is completed during the isolation period and returns negative, the employee may return to work prior to the 10 day isolation period, but must be asymptomatic.

In the past 24 hours, have you experienced any two of the following symptoms?

- New sore throat       Sudden fatigue       Diarrhea
- Muscle aches/pain       New onset of headache       Loss of taste/smell
- Vomiting       Abdominal pain

- If “yes” to **any two** of the above symptoms, the employee will be sent home.
  - You will isolate at home for a minimum of 10 days since the onset of symptoms.
  - In order to return to work, you must be symptom and fever free for **24 hours** without the use of fever reducing medications and complete a COVID-19 test (PCR or Antigen test).
  - If a test is completed during the isolation period and returns negative, the employee may return to work prior to the 10 day isolation period, but must be asymptomatic.
- If “no”, proceed to question 2.

2) In the past 14 days, have you been a close contact of a COVID-19 positive person or a person under investigation (PUI) **without wearing appropriate PPE**?

- If “yes,” date of contact:
  - The employee must agree to follow the critical infrastructure/essential workers protocol in order to continue to work.
  - If the employee does not agree to follow the critical infrastructure/essential workers protocol, the employee will be required to quarantine for 14 days from last exposure.

- If you are a close contact of a PUI and the PUI testing returns negative, you may return to work.
- If “no” proceed to having your temperature taken.

3) Check to see if the employee has a temperature of 100.4 degrees F or greater.

- If “yes” the employee will be sent home.
  - You will isolate at home for a minimum of 10 days since the onset of the fever.
  - In order to return to work, you must be symptom and fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications.
  - If a COVID-19 test is completed during the isolation period and returns negative, the employee may return to work prior to the 10 day isolation period, but must be asymptomatic.
  - If you develop any additional symptoms or have been a close contact of a confirmed COVID-19 positive individual, you should seek out medical attention.
  - If your temperature is 99.0 to 100.3, you will allowed to work. Your temperature will be checked in 2 hrs. If you are 100.4 or greater, you will be sent home. If your temperature is <100.4, you may continue to work with a mask.
- If “no,” you are able to work. **You must wear a mask during your shift.**
- Staff only need to be screened one time per day unless they are a close contact and working under the critical infrastructure/essential workers protocol.
