## **Pest Popping**

2. \_\_\_\_\_ Worms of the phylum Nematoda which have unsegmented, threadlike bodies and may be parasitic, microscopic worms.
3. \_\_\_\_\_ Insects.
4. \_\_\_\_\_ Mammals of the order Rodentia, such as rats and mice characterized by large front teeth adapted for gnawing or nibbling.
5. \_\_\_\_\_ Plants that are not green, such as yeasts, molds, smuts, and mushrooms, that cause diseases on other plants.
