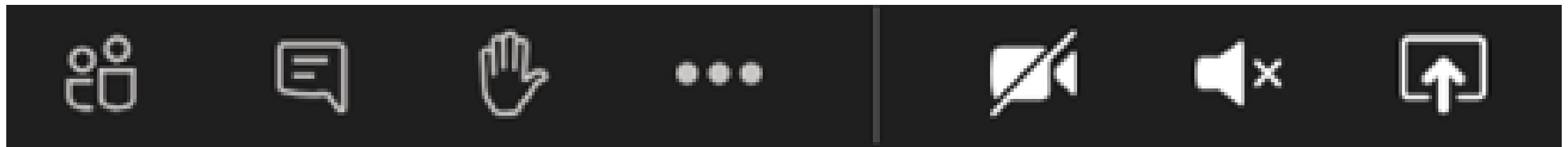



- Work with MPART to ensure that the general public is informed in a timely and coordinated manner



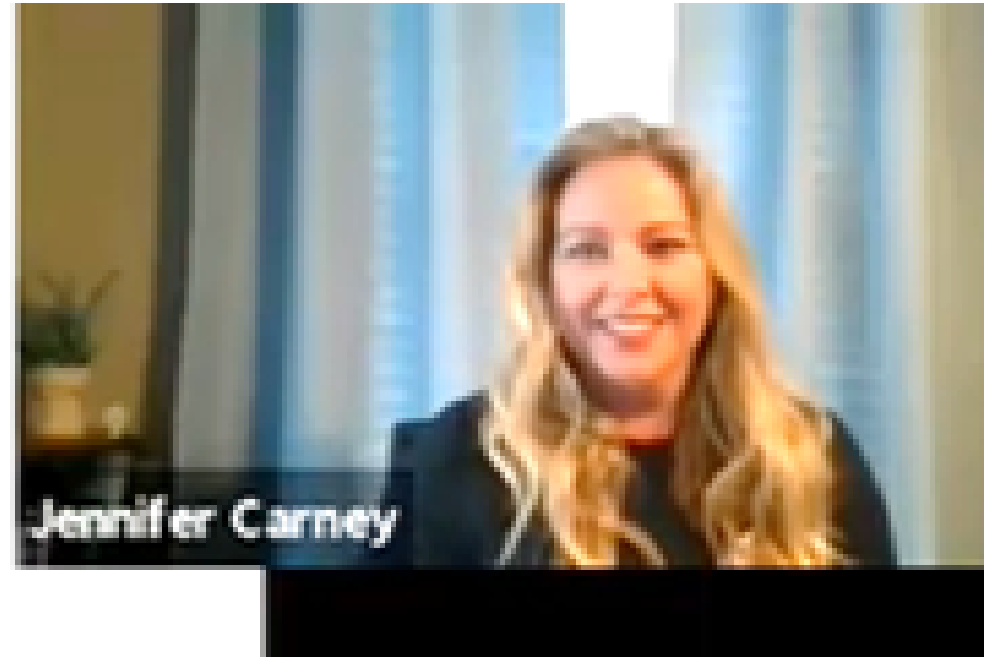
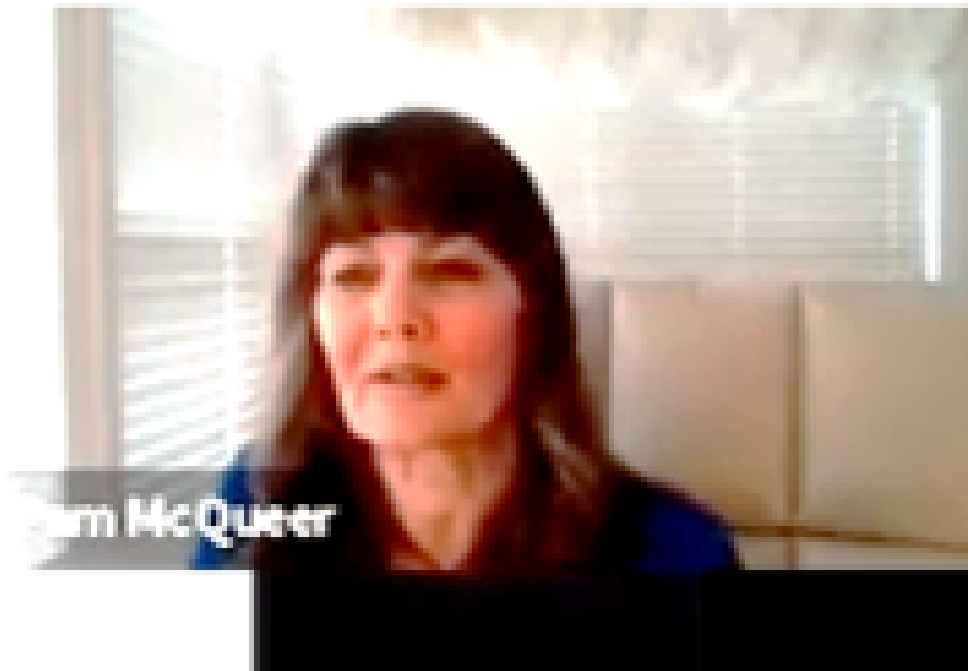
- Sounding board for process improvements

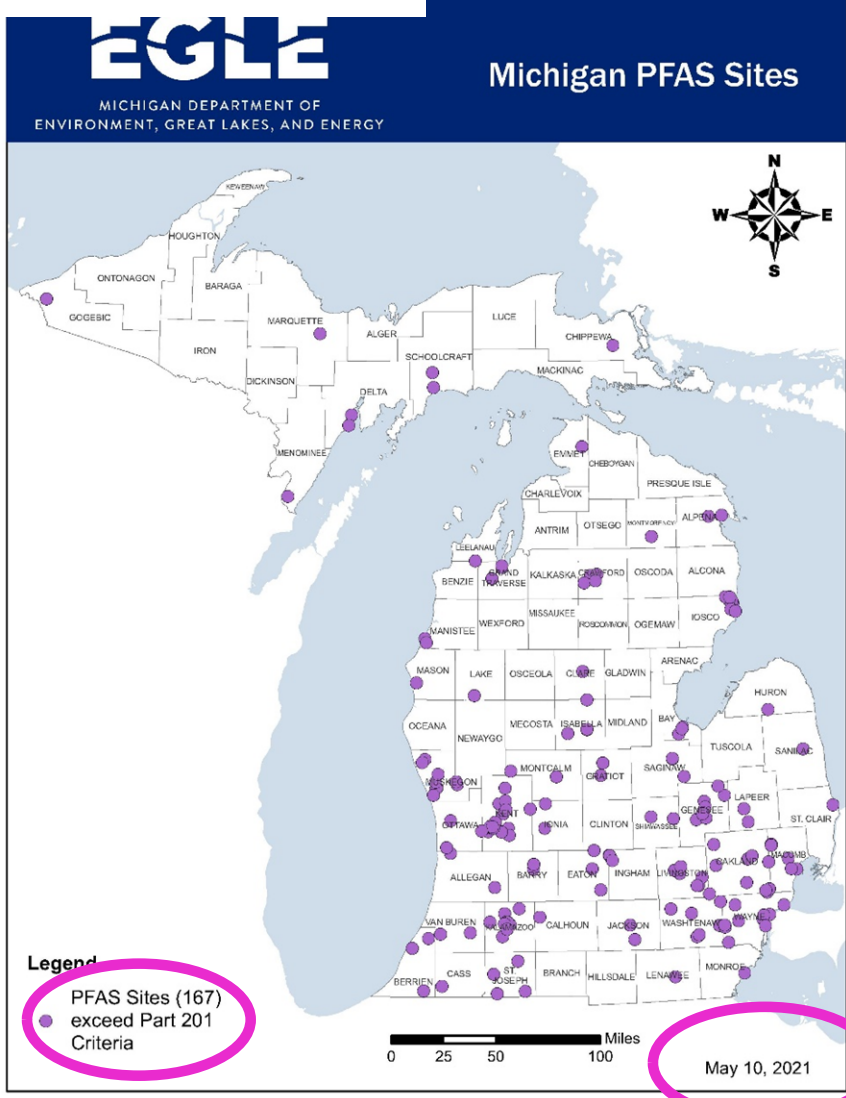
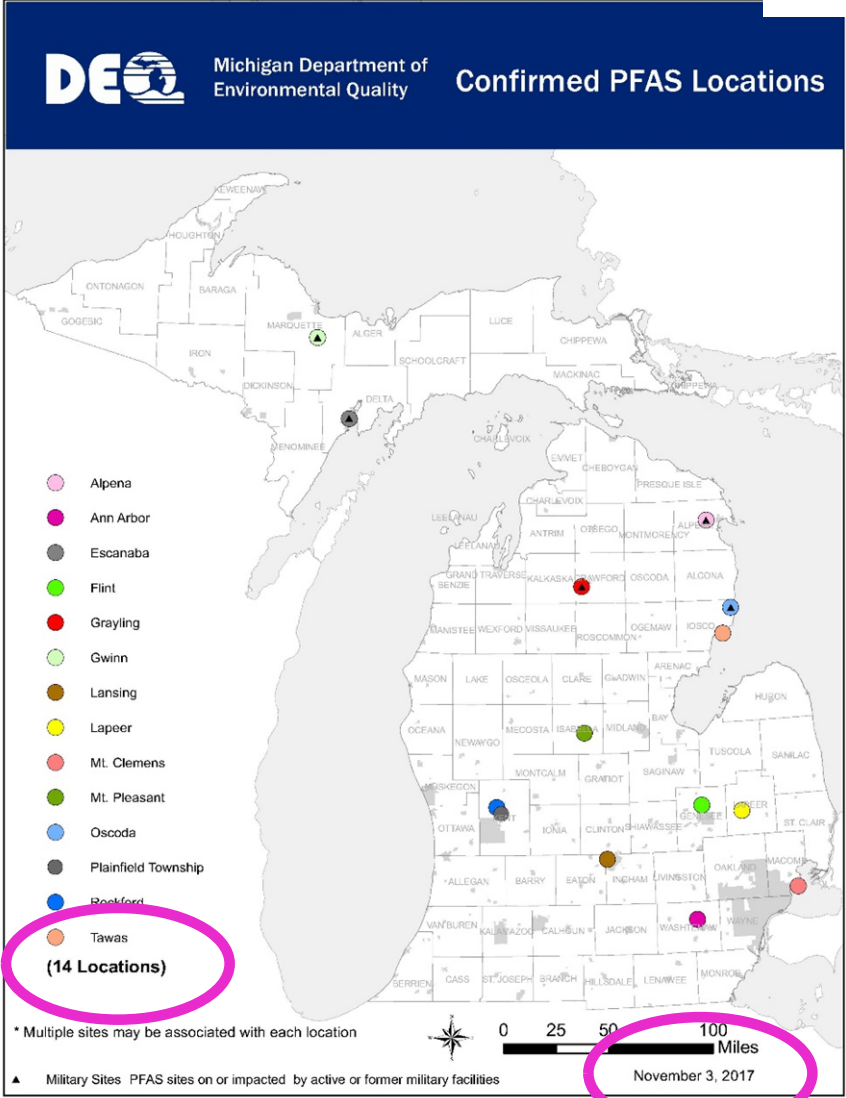

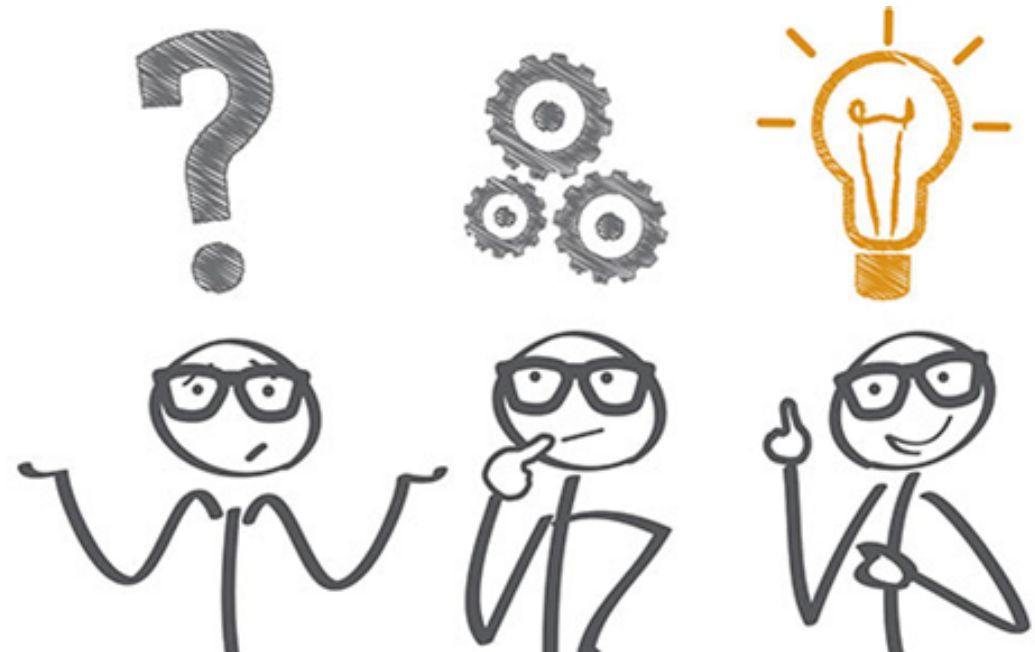

Notification Recommendation Scenarios

- When and How
 - Minimum Notification Recommendation
 - No drinking water impact site process



What's the message? Who gets notified?

Scenario A

- No data, suspected PFAS use, industry
- No nearby residential wells, municipal water is available
- Surface water is nearby

Scenario B

- No data, known PFAS release, AFFF related
- Might be residential wells nearby, municipal water is also available
- Surface water is nearby
