

FY 2019 BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS



- New resources to maintain and improve Michigan's roads and bridges now **exceed \$1 billion** — a **42.2% increase** since 2015.

- Strong support for K-12 education, with a **\$120-\$240 per-pupil increase** — the largest increase in the minimum per-pupil funding in more than 15 years.



- **\$58 million in new funding for school safety initiatives** across FYs 2018 & 2019, including school safety grants, school mental health counselors, and OK2SAY enhancements.



- **\$1 million** in grants to fund critically important programs designed to raise awareness and prevent campus sexual assault.

- **\$115 million** investment in the Rainy Day Fund, pushing the state's savings account to over \$1 billion.
