

\$74 MILLION ANNUALLY IS NEEDED TO ENSURE A SAFER, CLEANER ENVIRONMENT

2. SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT	\$9 million
 Enhance solid waste planning for local governments Increase asbestos removal oversight for blighted communities 	
3. RECYCLING GRANTS TO TRIPLE MICHIGAN'S RECYCLING RATE	\$15 million
 Provide recycling grants to local entities for recycling infrastructure, market development and education 	
4. WATER QUALITY MONITORING GRANTS	\$5 million
 Monitor beaches to keep them clean Reduce phosphorus in Lake Erie Remove contamination in rivers, lakes and streams
