

Increased safeguards required for Line 5

Enbridge Line 5 delivers products that fuel our state and heat our homes

The state will demand key safety measures under a new agreement with Enbridge

Replace the portion of Line 5 that crosses beneath the St. Clair River with a new pipe in a tunnel under the river

Temporarily shut down operation of Line 5 in the straits during periods of sustained adverse weather conditions

Implement measures to mitigate a potential vessel anchor strike on Line 5 beneath the straits

Expand state oversight of Enbridge actions and information

Study the placement of a new pipeline or pipelines in a tunnel beneath the Straits of Mackinac

Implement additional underwater technologies to better monitor the pipeline beneath the Straits of Mackinac

Implement measures to minimize the likelihood of an oil spill at other Line 5 water crossings in Michigan
