
MICHIGAN'S TECH INDUSTRY

■ The average tech industry wage in Michigan is **\$92,000**.

Michigan's tech sector was responsible for an estimated 7.5% or \$34.7 billion of the overall state economy in 2017.



The state also saw a 43.4% jump in the number of job postings related to emerging technologies, such as smart cities, drones, AI, machine learning, and virtual and augmented reality.



In total, Michigan employers posted 124,730 jobs for tech positions last year.

Leading tech occupations in Michigan include software and web developers, computer support specialists, and computer system and information security analysts.

The strongest year-over-year job growth occurred in the categories of R&D, testing, and engineering services and software.
